

Cottesloe Junior Football Club Registration for Season 2011

The Cottesloe Junior Football Club (the Mighty Magpies) warmly invites all current and new players (boys and girls) to register for Auskick (Pre-Primary to Year 3) or Junior Football (AFL) (Year 4 to Under 14's) for the 2011 season.

Auskick, commencing **Sunday 1 May**, is from 8.45am on Sunday mornings at Cottesloe Oval, corner of Jarrad and Broome Streets, Cottesloe (Harvey Field end). Sessions focus on introducing players to skills, participation and having fun! Parent involvement in sessions is encouraged. Auskickers receive a great backpack, including a cap, ball, drink bottle, and stickers.

Junior football, commencing **Sunday April 10** is organised in School Years 4, 5, 6 and age groups 12's, 13's, 14's and 15's involves playing games against other local clubs in the Claremont (and Subiaco 13's/14s & 15s) Junior District on Sundays. The emphasis in games and training is on participation, learning the positions on the ground, teamwork and fun.

Registration Day is Sunday, 20 February, from 10am until 12 noon, at the pavilion on our home ground, Cottesloe Oval, on the corner of Jarrad and Broome Streets, Cottesloe. Registration forms for junior teams and Auskick can be downloaded from our club website: www.cottesloejfc.com.

Forms can be completed and brought down to Registration Day and they will also be available on the day. Alternatively, they can be posted **with payment** to PO Box 483 Stirling Highway Cottesloe WA 6011.

Please make cheques payable to "Cottesloe Junior Football Club" (not Auskick) For players new to Junior Footy a birth certificate copy should be brought to Registration Day or the birth certificate number sighted on the registration form.

Fees for Junior Football (Year 4 to Year 9) are \$150 per player.
Fees for Auskick (Pre Primary to Year 3) are \$120 per player.
